Training cum Management Development Programme on Comprehensive Primary Health Care

Background

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has implemented a holistic programme 'Ayushman Bharat' to address issues of morbidity, reduce out-of pocket expenses, improve utilization of government health facilities, and to ensure continuum of care. The programme focuses on delivery of Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) through Health and Wellness Centers(HWCs). CPHC goes beyond the selective approach of health care towards a more comprehensive range of services including preventive, promotive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative care. Range of services have been expanded from Maternal and Child Health Care to care for non-communicable diseases, palliative care rehabilitative care, oral, eye, ENT care, mental health, first level care emergencies and trauma. To implement this programme in the urban sector, all the Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHCs) established under National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) are converted into Health and Wellness Centres (UPHC-HWCs).

The effective and efficient implementation of CPHC requires substantial change at various levels such as planning, service delivery, monitoring, financing, as well as active participation from different stakeholders like civil societies, NGOs, etc. A set of leadership and managerial skills is required to attain this change at all levels. Catering to this requirement, the training programme is designed to build capacity of professionals engaged in implementation of CPHC.

With this background, the State Unit of National Urban Health Mission in Kerala has designed a 2-day Training Programme on Comprehensive Primary Health Care mainly for the service delivery level professionals engaged with NUHM and the managerial personnel at the District Programme Management Units.

Objective

The major objective of the training programme is to enhance the awareness and competencies of the participants for better implementation of Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) through Health and Wellness Centers(UPHC-HWCs).

Contents

The training programme is designed to cover the following content:

- Understanding Health Systems
- Health Systems Building Blocks
- Comprehensive Primary Health Care: Basis for Strengthening Health system
- The Principles of Comprehensive Primary Health Care
- Essential Services designed under Comprehensive Primary Health Care
- Essential Diagnostics under Comprehensive Primary Health Care
- Quality Management of Primary Healthcare Services
- Communication and Analytical Skills
- Data Management and Analysis Skills
- Community Engagement and Field Action

Pedagogy

The proposed training programmes is planned with variety of t raining methods appropriately suitable for working professionals. The major training methods to be employed are lectures, discussions, group-work and presentations. The programme will be based on experiential learning and participatory approach. The lead concepts will be introduced by resource persons through lectures followed by discussions.
